

On the ground floor is a large living room of approximately 38 m², separate kitchen of 15 m², two of the four bedrooms and a shower room and a separate WC.

Two separate staircases connect to the first floor. The first one to a large sunlit bedroom of 18 m² and a library.

A second one leads to the next first floor bedroom of $14~\text{m}^2$ and also to large bathroom, a separate WC and the above mentioned sun room.

There is a large basement area with a former gym room, a cellar and a large garage with plenty of storage.

The terraces are east, south and west-facing and connect to a summer kitchen.

The house has a very high standard and quality and attention to details. There are custom-made quality cabinets and plenty storage facilities. There is air conditioning on the first floor and the main bathroom is equipped with twin basins and a corner whirlpool bathtub.

A large carport can be turned into a gîte or a studio. There is also a garden shed with plenty of storage.

The beautifully landscaped garden, with an automated irrigation system, is approximately 2800 m².

The property is in a very quiet area in a beautiful village.
