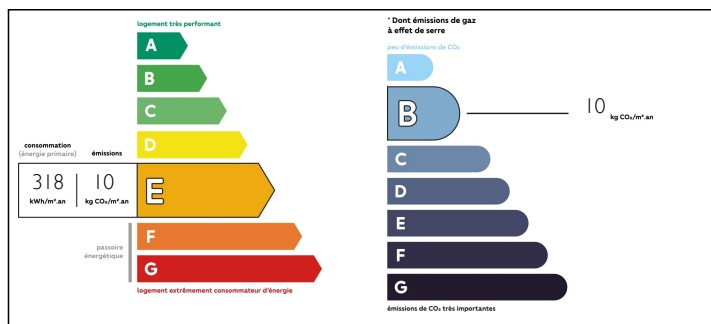

IN BRIEF

Nestled on the side of a wooded valley over which it watches with stunning views of the route the Pilgrim's way. The fortified La Joubertie, is a rare survivor from medieval times reconstructed in 1609/1611 and has considerable architectural merit. The garden which surrounds the house is well designed and richly planted with perennials and grasses for which the present owner is well known, with select trees and shrubs. The house is fully modernised, but has the potential to increase accommodation. The bustling market town of Vire is just 7 minutes away and can supply all your daily needs. There is a railway to Paris, a racecourse and easy access to major fast roads. Caen and Granville are equidistant, around 45 minutes, with their ferry ports, marinas and specialist shopping. DESCRIPTION

A stone-built house with a slate roof comprising:-
On the ground floor: entrance, kitchen, living room with fireplace, sitting room with fireplace, laundry room.

On the mezza floor: WC and cupboard.

On the first floor: two bedrooms with fireplaces, dressing room, bathroom, WC.

Top floor room and attic.

Adjoining the house and to be restored: two rooms:- a basement, a ground floor room and one room on the first floor.

Outside: a courtyard and driveway, a well and an agricultural building ripe for conversion to a gite on the land.
