

DESCRIPTION

This is a little gem. It has been thoughtfully renovated to provide, downstairs, a large living area with space for dining and a corner kitchen with stylish wall and floor units, and upstairs, three bedrooms. Two are on the first floor and the third is on an open mezzanine with etched glass ballastrade. The two velux windows provide a lot of natural light. All windows are double-glazed.

There's a (double) shower room with toilet and sink on the first floor, and a WC on the ground floor. There is also ample storage space, including walk-in cupboards on both the ground and first floors.

An art centre is a little up the road, and parking is at the top of the street and at the bottom by the river. Walks and cycle paths leave from and pass through the village.

There is no garden. The and the house is fully renovated ready to walk in. You can just arrive and enjoy what this beautiful area has to offer.
