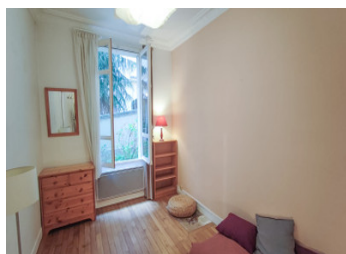

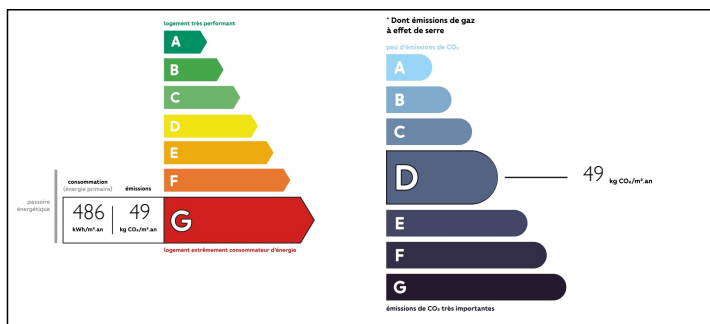

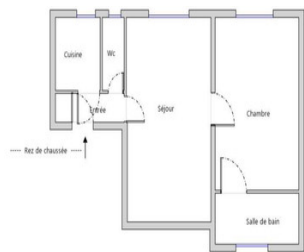

DESCRIPTION

Rue de Quatrefage is lined with traditional Haussmann-style buildings, giving the area a classic, elegant Parisian feel.

The street is within walking distance of the Jardin des Plantes and the Muséum national d'Histoire naturelle, two of the city's major attractions. It is also close to the Seine, offering pleasant walks along its banks.

The Jardin des Plantes district in Paris is one of the oldest and most charming in the city. Located in the 5th arrondissement, it offers a historic and picturesque atmosphere, while being close to many amenities and attractions.
