

DESCRIPTION

Very near the Abbey of Caunes Minervois, set in a lovely informal square shaded by plane trees, near the river and the ample village car park, this property is ideally situated in the village, 22 km from the mediaeval city of Carcassonne.

The building is entered by the original double doors, with cobbled floor inside. The main living, or restaurant area is also cobbled, and double-height, with a lovely gallery protected by the most wonderful curved timber balustrade.

At the rear is the kitchen, at a slightly higher level, with professional units and bar to divide it from the living or restaurant area. To the right is a smaller space, also for restaurant or residential use, which could be a snug or study area. The ground floor area is 60m^2 .

Just inside the entrance is a gorgeous WC area with grey and decorated traditional tiles. There is a 5m² storage space, and the building is partially double-glazed, with a large woodburner and electric heaters.

A timber stair leads to the first floor gallery area with more seating, a storeroom, and a terrace of $12m^2$.

On the top floor, the two lovely bedrooms each have their own white-tiled bathroom to suit the character of the building, and can be used as B&B rooms. There are 80m^2 in total on the two upper levels.

Inside the building the restaurant seats 25 downstairs and 15 on the gallery level. Outside there are tables for 30 people, but there is room for many more....
