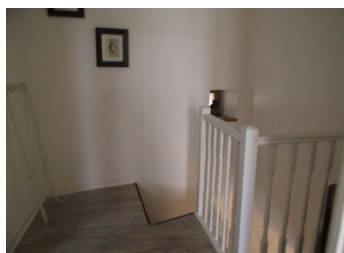
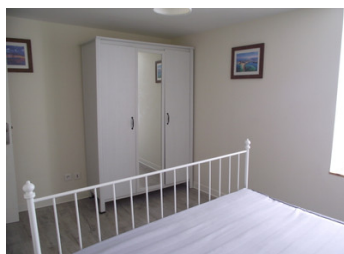


Lovely 2 bed village property, ready to go! A great, low maintenance holiday hideaway

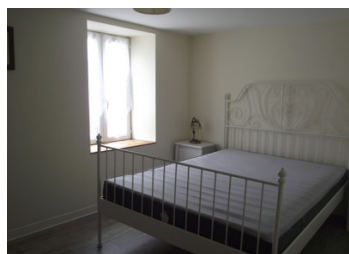

DESCRIPTION

Entry is into the main ground floor room which has a fitted kitchen with dining space and then a lounge area.
