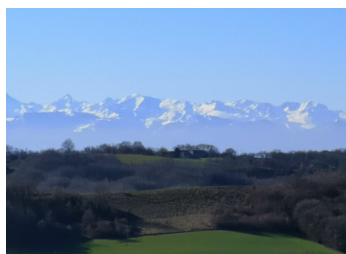

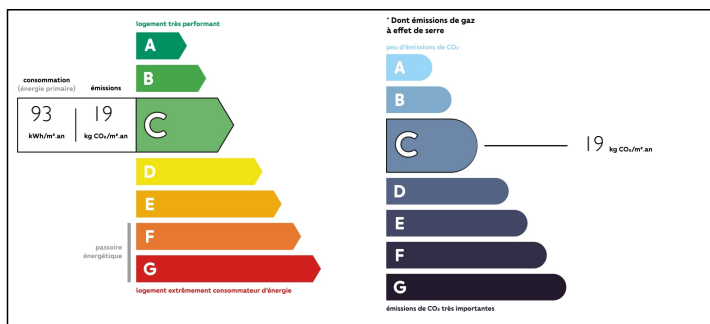

The building started as a hunting lodge for the local gentry and then a post office before it fell to ruin. In 2007 it was completely restored as a home.
