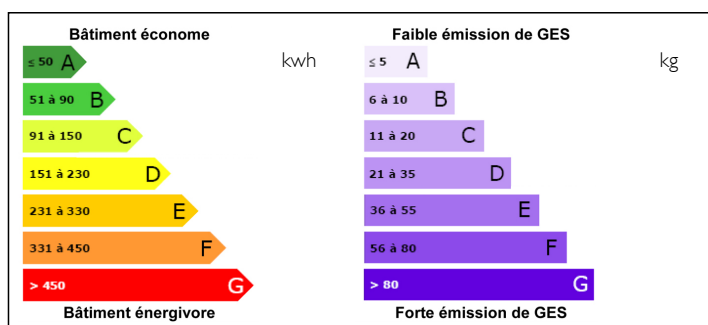

But the reward may be grand: you'll love the place that you'll create for yourself and for your loved ones as a pied à terre en Provence, close to the Lac de Saint Croix, the Gorges du Verdon and Moustiers Saint-Marie and Riez. 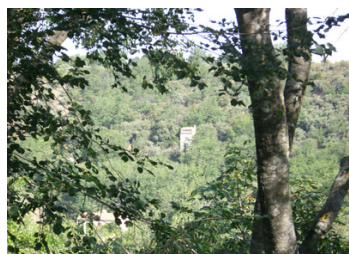

Since we are on a slope, the view is stunning and loads of sunshine (plain south !) will warm your heart. Left and right to the house there are two areas of level ground, where you can enjoy outdoor living: play, camp, eat, snooze

On the ground floor you'll find a small kitchenette and a fireplace and just enough space to place a small table for 4. The stairs will lead you to the first floor with a window with stunning views and just enough space for a queen sized bed Another set of stairs will lead you to the top floor with again stunning views and enough space for a small living room or another bedroom.

You may be missing the bathroom with the toilet ? You'll find it - very rudimentary - in the annex. Today, you'll have to walk outside to get there. The new owners may want to change that and open up a wall between the tower and the annex, which should be possible.

There are 3 water points on the lot of land; 2 outside and 1 inside.

The heating system is electric radiators.

The septic tank needs redoing, most like everything else.

Those who are both lovers of nature and renovation design work should take a close look.

You'll see the potential and you'll love the place. Promise.
