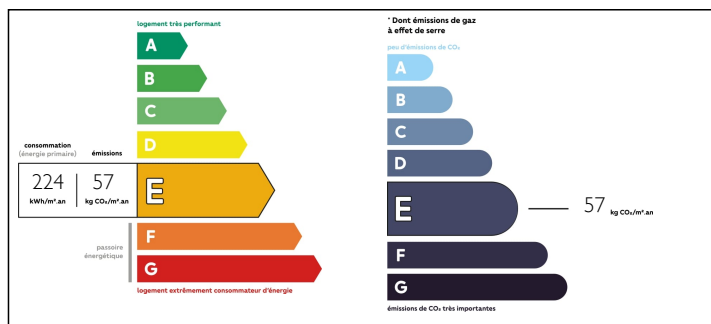

If you are looking for a real slice of history then go no further. This stunning house in Saint-Benoît-du-Sault is reaching out to you!

Packed full of character, this house has been tastefully redecorated whilst paying homage to the location. There are two entrances from the street. The main entrance floor up brings you into the reception lounge which features a large granite fireplace with wood burner. The double doors open onto a terrace and take in the views across the garden and the old ramparts not too far away. The room is of very generous proportions for this type of house and holds a secondary dining table and comfortable seating around the fireplace.

The Master bedroom is located on this level featuring polished tomette floor tiling and is of generous proportions. The family bathroom has been created on this level complete with a full size bath for relaxing after a day exploring the historic village. Another room on this floor is currently used as a third bedroom.

Downstairs the fully equipped kitchen features a built in oven and wooden benchtops. The use of bright colours and subway tiles blends well with the ancient wood beams and solid granite steps. The second bedroom mirrors the size of the large lounge above and comfortably holds two double beds and features another stone fireplace. There is a downstairs character shower room with WC.

Double doors from downstairs take you out onto a ground level terrace area. This provides fabulous options...
