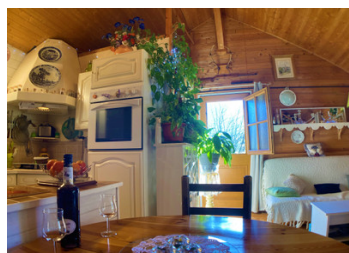
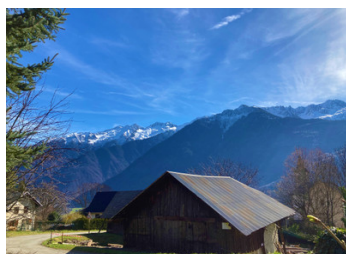
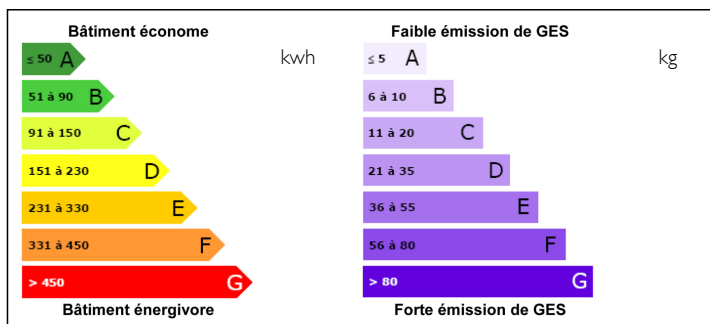

A rare opportunity to own a small traditional wooden chalet, with all modern services and great access.

The chalet is compact but provides everything you need for a 'getaway' location where you can enjoy the peace of french rural life and have access to some of the biggest alps ski areas within 30 minutes.

The chalet sits on a plot of 717m2 within a small hamlet. The garden surrounding the property provides amazing views but also corners of shaded area under the trees for sleepy afternoons in the hammock.

Inside, the living area provides a comfortable combined social area with kitchenette, sofa area and dining area all combined. A cosy double bedroom is situated to the rear along with a separated bathroom and toilet. The main living area has a high ceiling with exposed traditional wooden structure which along with the large windows creates and a very open space to enjoy.

Above the bedroom and bathroom a small mezzanine area currently used as storage can easily be opened up to provide a mezzanine bed area for a further 3 beds, ideal for a getaway location for the family.

A small larder completes the interior of the chalet. Heating is provided through the efficient traditional log stove and, rarely used electric radiators. Lighting has been nicely installed to illuminate the wooden roof structure within the property. A short staircase down from the parking area leads into the garden to the right of the chalet.
