

DESCRIPTION

The house is tucked away from a quiet road with a private driveway leading to the garden gates. Here one gets the first view of the house, garden and the stunning views beyond.

On entering the property, there is a large master bedroom to the right (39m2) and a bathroom (6m2) and toilet (3m2) to the left.

There is also a walk in closet (8m2) and pantry (9.5m2) and access to the converted dovecote. There is scope here on the ground floor to create another bedroom also.

From the corridor, we come through to the lovely fully fitted kitchen (21m2) with west facing panoramic views.

From the kitchen, there is an elegant and spacious living room (43m2) with wood burning stove, a bar area and French doors leading to the fantastic covered terrace and seating/outdoor dining area. Here the views really are something to behold.
