

Let's start the tour, push open the beautiful solid wood door and we're immediately charmed... A pastel-toned hallway leads us into a plush 15m2 study enhanced by large chestnut bookcases and sparkling display cabinets. Opposite is a 38m2 living room with a large fireplace, gleaming parquet floors and bathed in light thanks to a large bay window opening onto an incredible 20m2 veranda overlooking the sheltered parkland to the rear. Back in the hallway, we now return to the 16m2 dining room, extended by a luminous kitchen, which also opens onto the garden. You'll love the peace and quiet here - it's unbelievable how quiet it is just a stone's throw from the town centre! Up the stairs, a vast landing leads to 4 bedrooms, one of which is a 19m2 en suite master bedroom, adorned with beautiful painted wood panels and mouldings, and a shower room. Every room has its own charm! The charm of character homes combining comfort and practicality. Back on the ground floor, the red staircase leads down to the basement, a real bonus with a very fine 16m2 wine cellar, a 56m2 workshop with laundry and storage area, and a wood cellar.
