

Its large entrance hall contains the central staircase. To its left, the well-fitted kitchen/dining area looks south over the garden, the River Orbiel, and the hills. A cosy sitting area leads to a sunny west-facing living room with fireplace and two French windows leading onto a terrace and down to the garden.

The garden has been well-planted with flowers and fruit trees. It has a terrace on the riverside, a stone-walled courtyard area with lovely stone steps leading down from the road, and a backdrop of the grassy-terraced hill opposite. There are storerooms and a laundry room at garden level. The garage could be converted to give extra living space.

Back in the house, up the main stair are the study, large dressing room and main bedroom with its marble fireplace. Above this, the super main bathroom, with corner bath, shower and two washbasins, and the friends' bedroom. All face south onto the garden.

Off the very pretty first floor landing is a large bedroom with shower room en suite. A bathroom with corner bath faces west over the attractive village street.
