

DESCRIPTION

As you enter the front door there is a traditional Breton staircase leading to the further two floors. To the left is a large reception room (4.48×4.55) which at one time was a kitchen, with fireplace. New double glazed window at the back but front window single glazed. Across the hallway is the lounge (4.02×4.5) with a fire, one again with near double glazed rear window. At the rear of the hallway is a stone cubby hole that sticks out from the building which at one time housed a toilet.

Up the stairs, some renovations have been started with insulation and plasterboard but both rooms need to be completed. Bedroom I (4.6×4.2) Bedroom 2 (4.48×4.04) Inbetween is room for a bathroom with some plumbing (4×1.7)

Further up the stairs to the top floor there is another room (3.66 \times 4.14) with a new velux window. A room potentially for WC (1.8 \times 1.4) Further bedroom (3.944 \times 4.348)

The roof is in fairly good condition. The cellar (9.98×4.53) has an earth floor and at one time had stairs into the house but is currently only accessed via the side of the building.

The land is currently overgrown but could be landscaped into different levels to make a really lovely space to enjoy the incredible views.
