

This large house profits from having been sympathetically renovated. The roof, electricity installation and kitchen are all new.

There is a shady ground floor terrace which gives access to the front door. Inside there is a large L shaped living/ dining room with a pellet burner, a kitchen, a cloakroom, off to one side of the living room is a lovely summer room which in winter would serve to heat the whole house, a great feature!. Further on there is a laundry/utility room (pantry) and a large 3 car garage with mezzanine storage.

On the floor above there are 3 bedrooms, two of which open onto a large south facing terrace (one has a dressing room attached) and a very large master bedroom. Across the hall there is a bathroom with 2 showers and a w.c.

On the top floor level there is a large terrace with great views which goes around 2 sides of the house.
