

DESCRIPTION

Once past the entrance, a spacious living room with an open-plan kitchen invites you to relax by the fire, with its breathtaking views over the surrounding countryside and its recently installed wood-burning stove.

On the other side of the entrance hall is a bedroom, a lovely bathroom with shower and corner bath, a toilet and a corridor leading to the adjoining garage.

The staircase to the first floor leads to a landing with four bedrooms (two with fitted wardrobes), a study, a shower room and a toilet.

An outside staircase leads to the attic above the garage. The garden to the side and front of the house includes a second garage.

The house benefits from good energy efficiency thanks to the double-glazed windows, the existing crawl space and, above all, the installation of a double-flow ventilation system that distributes the heat generated by the wood-burning stove. In addition, there are electric radiators in every room. An electric hot water tank in the adjoining garage supplies the house with hot water. The septic tank is compliant. The roof structure and roofing are in excellent condition.
