
IN BRIEF

The property sits off a small country lane, with a long driveway through a little orchard and mature gardens which are mostly laid to lawn.

On the ground floor of the house is a semi open plan kitchen/dining room with exposed stone walls and beams and a wood burning stove. A large and light sitting room with triple aspect windows and a second wood stove. There is also a small utility room with space for white goods and a door to the rear of the house.

Upstairs there are 3 bedrooms, a family bathroom and a shower room.

The house has central heating throughout as well as double glazed windows.

Outside there is a garage/workshop which has electricity and is fully insulated; against the garage is a lean to wood store and extra outdoor storage space.
