




#### IN BRIEF

#### DESCRIPTION

The property sits in the centre of the quiet village with an unattached garden just a short stroll over the square.

Downstairs, a large living and dining area with a kitchen along one side, is the perfect spot to welcome guests for an aperitif or evening meal. There is a useful pantry and downstairs bathroom.

On the first floor, a spacious living area with woodburner leads onto a large terrace, a great sun trap for enjoying the warm days of summer. There is also a good sized bedroom with en suite shower room.

The top floor has two rooms that have been converted into cosy bedrooms as well as a separate toilet and a charming roof terrace that offers views over the village, to the fields and vineyards beyond. There is also a large store room accessible from outside underneath the larger terrace. The garden would be the perfect spot for growing a few vegetables or just setting up a table and chairs to admire the view of the vineyards and distant mountains.

This house would be the perfect holiday home or just a great spot from which to get to know this delightful part of France.

The village is less than 10 minutes from the pretty town of Fanjeaux with its cobbled streets, excellent restaurant and shops.
