

This beautiful early 1820 home is in excellent condition, built from tufa stone and located in a quiet, one-way street in the centre of Saumur. It is very close to all local amenities, including bars, restaurants, shops, the theatre, pharmacies and doctors.

The entry the property into a beautiful tilled hallway, leading to the generous reception rooms, kitchen, garage and the staircase leading to the upper floors.

The upper floors of the house enjoy beautiful views over the rooftops of the town, including a wonderful view of the Saumur Chateau.

For a home so centrally situated, this home also benefits from a private, spacious, well maintained and sunny garden, including pond, terrace and outbuildings.

The house requires no major work being completely renovated in 1997. The roof, wood treatment, plumbing, electrics, joinery and heating. The old gas boiler was also changed in 2021. The original character has been preserved, marble and oak floors, wood panelling, fireplaces, etc.
